

WHAT IS ANTERIOR SCLERITIS?

Anterior scleritis is a serious inflammatory disease of the sclera tissue. This condition is associated with many systemic diseases including lupus, rheumatoid arthritis, sarcoidosis, tuberculosis, herpes, rosacea, medications, and surgery. Scleritis can become very destructive and permanently reduce vision.

WHAT IS THE TREATMENT FOR ANTERIOR SCLERITIS?

Treatment includes treating the underlying condition, oral NSAIDs or oral corticosteroids.
